

Bottled Beer List

SAMUEL SMITH ORGANIC LAGER Tadcaster, North Yorkshire, England 355ml 5

This certified organic lager is a full-bodied beer with lots of malt and hop character. A touch hoppier than many lagers yet perfectly balanced.

SAMUEL SMITH ORGANIC ALE Tadcaster, North Yorkshire, England 355ml 5

This beautiful copper-colored certified organic beer is a delicately flavored golden ale with subtle hints of citrus fruit balanced by a background of maltiness and fresh hops.

PAULANER SALVATOR DOPPELBOCK Paulaner, Munich, Germany 500ml 5

This doppelbock has a dark red-amber hue. Outstandingly complex and fruity aromas show a deep malty expression that follows through on a full-bodied palate with roasted malt character and a sweet finish checked by modest bittering hops.

GRIMBERGEN BLONDE Alken Maes Brewery, Grimbergen, Belgium 330ml 6

A copper-colored, top fermented abbey beer created with a special selection of barley and hops. The light apple fruit is balanced by malty bitterness in this relatively light tasting beer.

WEIHENSTEPHANER LAGER Brauerei Weihenstephan, Friesing, Germany 500ml 6

This beer has a clear, light golden color, low level carbonation and a small white head. The aroma is crisp, flowery and herbal with a fresh bread roll dough background. The taste has a crisp clean hop with sweet and malty hints. An exceptionally well balanced lager.

MEANTIME COFFEE PORTER Meantime Brewing Company, London 330ml 7

Made with real caffeinated coffee, the initial flavor of this porter is very full coffee that fades to smooth chocolate and roasted malt notes. A mild bitterness in the finish brings coffee back to mind.

BELHAVEN SCOTTISH ALE Belhaven Brewery, Dunbar, Scotland 500ml 7

Malty and hoppy, Belhaven has been brewing this ale longer than any of the other beers they produce. This Scottish ale has a stunning ruby color in the glass and delivers a sweet, smooth and creamy finish.

HEN'S TOOTH OLD ALE Greene King, Bury St. Edmonds, England 500ml 7

This ale's balanced blend of strong, rich flavors leads to a satisfyingly smooth, clean finish. The active yeast in the bottle continues to condition and mature the ale through its life, producing not only the wonderful flavors but also a smooth, foamy head.

ALLAGASH WHITE Allagash Brewing, Portland, Maine 750ml 15

Brewed with a generous portion of wheat and a special blend of spices, this beer is light and slightly cloudy in appearance. Soft citrus and spicy aromas are followed by faint banana flavors in this refreshing beer.

LA FIN DU MONDE Unibroue, Quebec, Canada 750ml 15

Champagne-like effervescence combined with 9% ABV make La Fin Du Monde a great food pairing. Slightly tart with earthy hops are defining characteristics of this big, smooth beer.

BROTHER THELONIOUS North Coast Brewing, Ft. Bragg, California 750ml 15

Like a Belgian "Dark Strong Ale," this beer is rich and robust with an ABV of 9.3%. Aromas of dark fruit, caramel and clove are also on the palate, with hints of scotch, orange peel and sweet tobacco.

TROIS PISTOLES Unibroue, Quebec, Canada 750ml 15

Brewed with four selected malts and four exotic spices, Trois Pistoles beckons with a subtle sweetness that makes it surprisingly smooth for a beer of such strength and complexity.

LE MERLE North Coast Brewing, Ft. Bragg, California 750ml 15

A rustic Saison styled ale, pale straw in color, inspired by the rich brewing traditions of the Flanders region. Abundant hops and a Belgian yeast strain contribute exotic aromas of tropical fruit.

MEANTIME LONDON PORTER Meantime Brewing Company, London 750ml 15

This porter offers light roast malt on the nose and on the palate a sweetish caramel gives way to a mouthful of smoky, dry maltiness. The pleasing astringency on the finish comes entirely from the brown, black and chocolate malts rather than hops.

ST. FEULLIEN TRIPLE ABBEY ALE, Le Rœulx, Belgium 750ml 15

This beer has a white, smooth and very compact head. Its pale amber color is very characteristic revealing a distinctive maltiness. It has a rich aroma with a unique combination of aromatic hops and spices. The strong and exceptionally lingering taste can be attributed to its density and long storage period. A truly great beer.

DELIRIUM TREMENS Huyghe Brewery, Melle/Ghent, Belgium 750ml 16

The color of this intricate beer is golden brown and the head is creamy and light. It is lightly hopped and surprisingly malty for such an airy and sunshiny beer.

DUVEL SPECIAL BELGIAN ALE Moortgat Brewery, Belgium 750ml 16

This is an intense, aromatic and beguiling ale. The beer pours a brilliant golden yellow color with a very large frothy white head. Duvel is highly carbonated--think champagne--and refreshing. Look for the scents of citrus fruit, with hints of apricot and banana.

TRIPLE KARMELIET BROUWERIJ Bosteels, Belgium 750ml 17

You get a big yeasty hit upon first sip, followed up with some honey-like sweetness. As the beer warms notes of lemon zest, black pepper and floral hops creep through.

HOUBLON CHOUFFE DOBBELEN IPA TRIPEL Achouffe, Belgium 750ml 17

The hop impact of the aroma is subtle and incredibly pleasing. This beer has a delicate citrus floral and fruity flavor that plays with the nose and palate.

ALLAGASH CURIEUX Allagash Brewing, Portland, Maine 750ml 22

A Triple Ale, aged in Jim Beam barrels for 8 weeks. During the aging process in these bourbon barrels, the beer picks up soft coconut and vanilla characteristics and also a hint of bourbon flavor.
